IRC Re-Roofs Louisiana Superdome

When the state of Louisiana was deciding which roof system to install on the Superdome after Katrina ripped off the EPDM (rubber) roof, they had one question in mind, "what system has the best wind rating?" When they installed the EPDM roof in 2002, they were assured that the roof would survive 200 mph winds (Katrina had winds of 74 to 95 mph in New Orleans according to the National Weather Ser-


vice). At the end of August, 2006, the Associated Press reported that the state and their insurer filed a lawsuit against all parties involved in the project for the catastrophe.

At the end of the day, after researching all available roof systems on the market, the architects, engineers & consultants for the state recommended the installation a spray polyurethane foam (SPF) roof.


The state of Louisiana endorsed the recommendations and sent the project out for bid.

Once contracts were awarded, work began immediately in order to complete the project before the Saint's first home game. The remaining roof was removed as well as complete replacement of the steel decking. The new SPF roof system was applied directly to the new deck and a urethane coating was applied.

The State of Louisiana was issued a 10 year manufacturers warranty against leaks and also guaranteed the roof would not blow off, even in a Category V hurricane. The warranty has no dollar limit and is non-prorated.

What is a Wind Warranty???

A wind warranty is being offered from Baysystems North America, a subsidiary of Bayer Chemical. It specifically warrants that the roof will not blow off due to high winds, up to and including Category V hurricanes. Baysystems will replace any roof area removed due to high winds at their sole expense.

"I have heard from numerous facility owners on the coast that are saying their

insurance companies will not provide wind insurance at any cost" says Sean Stumler, VP Sales for IRC. "From what I understand, a few insurance companies will write wind policies but it is so expensive, most can't afford it".
